13. METHOD OF COMPETITION AND CONTEST TIME

- Single elimination tournament system.
- Best of three (3) system will be used.
- Senior divisions: 3 (2) rounds of 2 minutes, 1-minute break between each round
- Junior divisions: 3 (2) rounds of 1.5 minutes, 1-minute break between each round
- Cadet divisions: 3 (2) rounds of 1.5 minutes, 1-minute break between each round

The Technical Delegate has the authority to adjust the contest time as he sees fit.

15. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Athlete License.
2. Member of the team/club of a pertinent Member National Association, recognized by European Taekwondo Union or World Taekwondo
3. Holder of Kukkiwon Dan certificate
4. Juniors must hold at least 2nd Gup
5. Cadets must hold at least 4th Gup
6. Seniors: An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in 2008 or before
7. Juniors: An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in 2008, 2009, 2010
8. Cadets: An athlete in order to be eligible for participation must be born in 2011, 2012, 2013

All competitors must prove their age by presenting their passport or identification card at the official weigh in. For those athletes that are not adults, a written letter of consent must be submitted (please find enclosed on the last pages) at the registration, signed by one of the parents or legal guardians, accepting their participation and all parts of the official invitation.

16. COACH ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum age of 18 years
2. Holder of the WT Coach License Level I Coach Certification
3. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Official License
4. Coach is not allowed wearing Dobok
5. One (1) coach per five (5) athletes is allowed. Exceeding this ratio is subject to an extra fee.

17. MEDICAL STAFF ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum age of 18
2. Holder of a valid 2025 WT Global Official License.

17. SPORT ENTRIES

Team entries will only be accepted through the WT GMS online registration system Simply Compete. Registration of the athletes is only possible with a valid 2025 WT Global License (GAL issued by assigned GMS club, Edition and Administrators only).

19. APPLICABLE FEES

REGULAR ENTRY FEE

150 euro per registered athlete, paid until 11th May 2025.

LATE PAYMENT ENTRY FEE

175 euro per registered athlete, paid after 11th May 2025.

ON-SITE CHANGE OF MEDAL EVENT (WEIGHT CATEGORY)

50 euro for each weight change after the deadline. Change of weight category it's only possible at registration before general weigh in.

ADDITIONAL ACCREDITATION CARDS

50 euro for each on-site approved additional requested accreditation card.

EXTRA COACHES

50 euro for each coach exceeding the 1:5 ratio.

PROTEST FEE

200 euro. In case of an official protest submitted according to WT Rules, a non-refundable 200 euro fee shall be paid. Make sure the protest form is used (attached at the end) and be aware that the protest is made in time.

All teams are required to send proof of payment (copy of bank transfer) to info@elot-tkd.gr , finance@europetaekwondo.org within one (1) week after registration in Simply Compete or submit it at the registration appointment booking platform. The Organizing Committee has the right to delete sport entries from teams that do not send proof of payment from the system in order for other athletes to register and to prevent 'ghost athletes.

Any athlete registering on-line who does not take part in the competition and who has not been removed from the entry list before the deadline 11 May 2025, is fully liable for paying his/her entry fee in full. For any athlete not presenting at registration, his/her team or official shall be liable for ensuring full payment of the entry fee of the aforementioned athlete prior to the team's participation. If a team does not show up at the event and has not requested a participation cancellation before the deadline, the Organizing Committee shall invoice the team for the full amount (100%) as per current outline.

22. NO REFUND POLICY

The Organizing Committee shall not refund entry fees paid.

23. SPORT EQUIPMENT

1. **PSS:** KPNP Gen 1 scoring system with electronic head gear and face mask for Cadets
2. **Mats:** Recognized by World Taekwondo matts will be used.

All contestants must bring their own WT recognized equipment (groin, forearm, shin, mouthpiece, gloves and sensor socks)

24. MEDICAL & ANTI-DOPING

The WT Anti-Doping Rules, and if it is necessary, the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency, shall apply throughout the competitions.

1. Compulsory anti-doping tests may be carried out for selected medalists, whilst random tests may be conducted to the rest of the athletes. The WT and/or WADA may carry out random out-of-competition testing prior to the championships.
2. TUE (Therapeutic Use Exemption): Athletes who intake any substance or medicine listed in the "Prohibited List" of the WT Anti-Doping Rules and Anti-Doping Code of World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) for therapeutic purposes are requested to submit TUE applications via ADAMS, enclosed with the required medical information. In case you are not registered on ADAMS system yet, please contact tue@ita.sport, to create an account. Otherwise, please download the TUE Application Form tue@ita.sport, which thou shalt be completed, signed and sent including the required medical file, to: tue@ita.sport

27. INDEMNITIES

It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure that their athletes and team officials have duly completed and signed indemnification forms, thereby indemnifying WT, ETU, the Organizing Committee and all other officials and athletes from any claims of injuries, losses or otherwise arising during participation at the Greece Open 2025 or any activities linked therewith. It is the responsibility of each registered team to ensure and guarantee that sufficient insurance coverage has been arranged for all athletes, team officials and other participants. Without sufficient insurance coverage, teams will not be allowed to compete.

Please fill out the Personal Indemnity Forms and return them to the Organizing Committee before 11th May 2025. Each participant (athletes, team officials, etc.) must fill out the indemnification form.



28. MEDICAL INSURANCE

All participating athletes, coaches, team officials, technical officials and participants at ETU events shall have mandatorily an international medical insurance that covers medical care (COVID included) and in case of emergency, repatriation to the country of origin, valid on the days present in the host country of the event. ETU nor the Organizing Committee shall be responsible to cover any medical costs incurred for medical treatment before, on or during the competition or repatriation in the broadest sense of the word. All relevant documents proving that such an insurance is present, including insurance policy papers, should be taken to the event in case a medical situation occurs. Each MNA, Team doctor or team medical staff must ensure their athletes and team officials have valid international health insurance that covers medical and emergency care at the designated hospitals in Greece before arrival to the venue.

General

The OC cannot predict the developments in the next months regarding to the Corona COVID-19 outbreak in Europe. The teams have to keep in mind that due to the uncertain nature of the Corona COVID-19 outbreak and sole authority of each government on how to respond, restrictions to access the Host country may be applicable. It is the responsibility of each and every participating team to ensure they comply all entry requirements in order to enter the Host country and to monitor the Greek policy regarding to entry policies.

Sufficient insurance

The teams are strongly urged and advised to confirm to have their own sufficient travel, cancellation, medical insurance.

Liability

On this point, please be informed that the OC shall not and cannot be held liable for any expenses and costs incurred by the teams for travelling to the event in case of cancellation of the event due to (further) outbreak of the Corona COVID-19 virus in the Host Country. The teams are strongly urged and advised to confirm to have their own sufficient travel, cancellation and medical insurance. The OC shall not accept any claims or requests for compensation in case of cancellation of the event.

29. VISA

Visa forms should be sent back to info@elot-tkd.gr by **the 25th of April 2025, 23:59 CET**. Forms sent after the 25th of April 2025 will not be accepted for any reason. All wrong information provided (mistakes in names, document numbers, dates, etc.) – is the applicant's responsibility.

To get a visa invitation, you need to send:

1. Proof of registration in GMS.
2. Proof of accommodation.
3. Filled the Visa application form.
4. Provide passport copies to all visa applicants.

Please be informed that the OC cannot speed up visa applications or contact embassies on behalf of visa applicants.

If any applicant does not get your visa on time, the payments are not refundable at any time.
